We can enter through the front entrance through the double doors.




INSIDE THE OPERA HOUSE - GROUND FLOOR

There will be friendly staff there taking tickets.






INSIDE THE THEATRE - GROUND FLOOR

If we need wheel chair seats they will be close to the entrance on either side.




THE OPERA HOUSE - 2ND FLOOR

INSIDE THE THEATRE - SECOND FLOOR

To enter the theatre on the second floor we walk through the double doors framed by curtains.

The second floor of the theatre is high up and the stairs are steep.
